

## **ODESSA MEYER ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP**

The minimum award is \$1,000 a year for up to 5 years. The purpose of the award is to develop and support the scholarly excellence of EAF doctoral students from underrepresented groups. Priority will be given to doctoral students from underrepresented groups interested in participating in scholarly activities. [Apply to the Odessa Meyer Endowed Scholarship.](#)

Eligibility requirements:

- The student must be an EAF doctoral student from an underrepresented group
- The student must demonstrate strong academic and research potential in classes and remain in good academic standing throughout the duration of the scholarship award.
- The student must demonstrate an interest in, and potential to, participate in scholarly activities.
- The student must collaborate with an EAF faculty member who agrees to serve as mentor for up to five years. The faculty member must write a letter supporting the student's application, addressing:
  - Student's academic ability and interest in pursuing scholarly activities
  - Short- and long-term goals and activities for the student over the five-year period

If a faculty member is unable to continue serving as a mentor to the student, the EAF department chair will work with the student to identify another mentor for the remaining duration of the scholarship.
